This is a unique opportunity to play an integral role in shaping the political landscape for Latino voters.

- Identify, educate, and empower local volunteer activists on the importance of civic participation.
- Build coalitions among allies and underrepresented constituencies to increase civic participation.
- Implement LPC field and outreach strategies in key communities; including issue-grassroots advocacy actions, voter education, early voting, phone banking, GOTV, and neighborhood canvassing.
- Host and attend community events on behalf of LPC.

- Experience engaging and motivating large numbers of volunteers.
- Experience organizing phone banks and door-to-door canvassing.
- Experience working collaboratively with other social justice / non-profit organizations.
- Ability to work under pressure and think quickly.
